Den Mtgs: 6:50-8:30 p.m. - every Monday

Line up outside the Outback building by 6:50 p.m. Please make sure your son is in his <u>complete</u> <u>uniform</u> and has his <u>Scout handbook</u>. After a brief flag presentation, your

son will go with his fellow scouts to a specified room for their den meeting. (see map) Parents are welcome to observe and help out.

<u>At 8:15 p.m.</u>, parents must pick up their son in this room, as scouts will not be released on their own. At this time we will review any necessary information/homework with you.

Pack Mtgs:	<u>7:00-8:00 p.mlast Monday of each month in the Outback.</u> Cub scouts <u>AND</u> parents are asked to attend these. Each month your son will be recognized and sometimes be performing. It is so important to your son for you to be there and we do not want you to miss out! As a den, you are responsible to provide cookies at two of the pack meetings. Each scout will need to bring in one package of cookies on that particular night.
Flag Duty:	<u>6:40 p.m. on specified Mondays</u> (see calendar) Throughout the year, your den is scheduled for flag duty/presentation. On these particular nights, your son will need to arrive at 6:40 p.m. inside the Outback room to practice.
Volunteers:	WE NEED YOU! The only way to make our pack run as efficiently as possible is to rely on our parent volunteers. There are several events during the year that need help from all of the parents in the pack, as well as den specific events.
Absences:	If your son is absent from a den meeting, he will need to make up the activities on his own and turn in the necessary paperwork in order to earn that achievement.
Bobcat Trail:	If your son has not been a scout before or did not earn his Bobcat patch, this is the first thing he MUST work on right away! Refer to his handbook. Each night have him practice all eight tracks for the Bobcat Trail. Notify a den leader as soon as he has these mastered. During the pack meeting, you and your son will be in front of his peers as he says and does these requirements. No <i>worries! We will be there</i> to <i>guide and assist him if needed</i> . At this time, he will receive his Bobcat pin, which will be pinned on upside down. To have his pin turned right side up, your son will need to do five good deeds (that are not his normal chores) during the next few weeks. At the next monthly pack meeting, he will need to tell what five good deeds he did.
